4. PUBLIC COMMENT

Discussion ensued about getting a list of streets with their blocks that are going to be rebuild this year, so we don't plan any trees there.

Status of the RFP with Maplewood is they are drafting right now. Team will review draft around the 22nd with the goal that is out by the 1st.

5. REPORTS

- Public Works – Things get put on hold when we have a snow storm. When weather permits the striping will get done. When it snows we cannot prep, clean up, no asphalt work can be done. Even following snow events time is taken out to fix the plows, chains, and/or washing snow off truck.
 - General Report
 - Recycling Facility – Recycling Yard has been improved, cleaned up the yard, entire right side is clear of debris.
- Water Utility
 - General Report – We have had a rush of water main breaks. Normally 1 or 2 a year, we have had 5 in February due to quick changes of temperature in January. We will start replacing meters



throughout the Village. As part of the meter replacement we will determine the material of the service line going into the home.

- Discussion ensued about having info on lead on our website. Maybe we can have pending dates on the website? Any tips or service providers so residents can test on their own.
- 2022 Budget – Will review ASAP and will then be made public.
- **Joint Meeting of Essex & Union County (sewer)**
 - General Report – Average flow was 3,105,000 million gallons per day.
- **Engineer -**
 - General Report – Will be including trees in all the contracts, there will be tree removal and planting. Discussion ensued about getting street lights to replace gas lines but cannot be done at the moment.
 - Roadwork Review – Will start surveying roads, FEMA wants all 6 FEMA roads to be completed this year. Discussion ensued about the speeding on West End Road and designing the road with chicanes so drivers are forced to slow down.
 - Stormwater / Stormwater Ordinance 2022 – 07 – First reading this past Monday. Second reading is 3/14/22.
 - River Greenway – Had a meeting last week, design engineer is addressing any concerns.
 - Squire House – still coordinating with DEP. Will be following up.
