- A. Essex County Valley Street and South Orange Avenue Intersection Improvements presented by County representatives: Asif Mahmood, Bruce Klien and Andrew Larsen.

The presentation was pertaining to safety improvements to eleven (11) intersections that were identified as having high crash histories among Essex County intersections. The following are the 11 intersections which are located in Maplewood and South Orange:

- Valley Street & Millburn Avenue
- Valley Street & Tuscan Road
- Valley Street & Baker Street
- Valley Street & Oakview Avenue
- Valley Street & Oakland Road
- Valley Street & Parker Avenue
- Valley Street & Third Street

Also discussed were the purpose and need, project funding, planned improvements, intersection specific improvements, timeline, schedule and next steps. In response to board questions, it was discussed that Hixon Place, Arnold Terrace, Roland Avenue and South Orange Avenue will be a part of the next project improvement phase. Mr. Mahmood discussed red turning signals, striping on crosswalks at Irvington Avenue, bump out construction, and signal timing on Valley Street to slow traffic. In response to public questions, Mr. Klien discussed timing of construction, traffic plan during construction, possibility of a left turning lane at Third Street, pedestrian plan during construction and traffic study due to the increase pedestrian traffic on Valley Street.

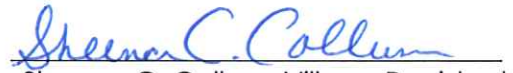
