3. Minutes Approval for the July 2021 CPC meeting with unanimous consent by all voting members present.

A. Trustee Liaison Report –

B. PD Report –

Acting Chief Dolinac provided an update with regards to the public surveillance camera program. Acting Chief Dolinac expressed appreciation for the public forum that was held in July and noted that public feedback was being reviewed as the village and PD develop procedure and policy related to the use of the cameras. Member Davis had questioned whether the CPC would have legal representation as a general matter as it related to the CPC developing positions related to policy recommendations. Trustee Coalier confirmed that the CPC as a committee under the village would have access to the village attorney.



Additionally, Acting Chief Dolinac noted that the body camera program, which is required by the state, was also being funded by the state and such funding and procurement was ongoing for South Orange.

C. CCJ Liaison report –

Secretary Gioello noted that the CCJ program was moving ahead and now had a full time licensed social worker, Kristen Miller. Ms. Miller introduced herself and provided an overview of the progress the CCJ program has made, including:

1. Welcoming three MSW students to the program this fall.
2. Launching of programs related to suicide awareness and domestic violence.
3. The launch of the CC&J survey.

There was also a discussion related to programs/individuals who may be able to assist in the suicide prevention initiative. Member Ryan and Ms. Miller will speak offline.

Secretary Gioello noted that members had expressed concern that the CPC was not involved in National Night Out. There was ongoing discussion about connecting the CPC community outreach team to the PD directly to develop a plan to work together on these types of events going forward.
